Local Disaster Declaration

WHEREAS, the County of Deaf Smith on the 1st day of May, 2022, has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of property resulting from

A historic hail storm, and

WHEREAS, the County Judge D.J. Wagner of Deaf Smith County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE D.J. WAGNER OF DEAF SMITH COUNTY:

That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Deaf Smith County pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.

Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the DEAF SMITH COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT.

Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the Deaf Smith County Clerk.

Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the Deaf Smith County emergency management plan.

That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance. ORDERED this 6th of May, 2022.
